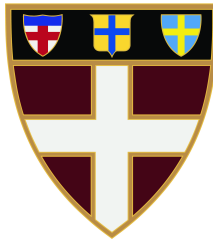

SSM DRESS CODE for Spring Term 2021

All students at Shattuck-St. Mary's School are always expected to be neat, tidy, and appropriately dressed. The uniform is in effect Monday-Thursday during the regular school day (9:00 a.m. to 4:20 p.m.). Students out of uniform will be asked to change and will be issued a white card by his/her teacher, advisor, other faculty member, or an administrator. Students who need to change clothes for a specific class (e.g., dance) must change back into the school uniform immediately following the class. The uniform may also be required on off-campus excursions. Faculty members are always the final judges of what constitutes "appropriate dress."

For Spring Term 2021, the dress code for a typical Friday, or any other day designated as a non-class day, will be the same as a "Jeans Day" as noted below.

Boys Dress Code:

- **Shirts:** maroon, black, or white polo shirts that are branded with any SSM approved logos. Shirts must be tucked in.
- **Pants:** Uniform pants or uniform shorts purchased from Lands' End School Uniform website.
- **Belts** must be worn and visible at all times.

Girls Dress Code:

- **Shirts:** maroon, black, or white polo shirts that are branded with any SSM approved logos.
- **Skirts/Pants:** Uniform pants, uniform shorts, uniform skirts, or uniform capris purchased from Lands' End School Uniform website.

Additional Clothing Layer Options:

Sweatshirts, fleece jackets, or sweaters that are branded with any SSM logo (including any Center of Excellence logo) that have been sold either at the SSM school store or through the Lands' End uniform website may be worn on top of a SSM uniform polo shirt. Items in school

colors (maroon, black, or white) that do not have an SSM logo are not acceptable. A SSM uniform polo shirt must always be worn underneath any sweatshirt, fleece jacket, or sweater.

Shoes:

Students may wear leather shoes or athletic shoes in good repair. Birkenstock style sandals are acceptable, but no other style of backless sandal of any material is acceptable.

Hats/hoods:

Hats, stocking caps, or raised hoods may not be worn in the academic buildings.

Special Occasion Dress:

On special occasions, students may be allowed to be out of school dress as determined by the Director of Community Life. Examples include Mock Trial and game-day dress. Expectations will be defined upon approval of special occasion dress.

Formal Events:

Several formal events are held each school year. Examples of these events include Christmas Chapel/Dinner, Baccalaureate, and Senior Dinner. Appropriate attire includes suits and ties for boys and dresses for girls.

Jeans Days:

Upon declaration of a "Jeans Day" by the School, denim will be allowed. Less casual attire, such as athletic pants, leggings, and cargo shorts are allowed on such days. Clothes with rips, tears, or significant holes are not allowed. Students not dressed properly will be required to change. Students not participating in donation-based jeans day are expected to be in school uniform.

General Expectations:

- Facial hair (mustaches, beards, long sideburns, etc.), mohawks, bizarre hairstyles, hair dye (colors other than normal hair shades), hats, facial piercings, excessive make-up, heavy chains, dog collars, and spikes are prohibited during the class day.
- Clothing displaying inappropriate language, graphics depicting tobacco, alcohol, illegal substances, nudity, or crude content is prohibited at all times.
